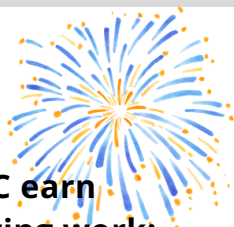

**WVC is taking steps to address
RECOMMENDATIONS about:**



- Completion of financial audits and budget transparency.
- Developing policy and procedures related to regular and substantive interactions in distance education.
- Maintaining a safe, accessible, secure Omak campus with sufficient staffing and facilities to ensure academic integrity and delivery of student support services.
- Clarify decision-making processes to engage employees and students in effective communication and management practices.



Actions underway to address recommendations include the development of a Communication Plan, drafting a Decision-Making Matrix, and hiring a facilitator to work with cabinet to improve management practices. Dr. Harrison will meet with the Commission in July and the Commission will provide a final action letter to the college in August. Work to respond to the RECOMMENDATIONS will continue over the summer and information will be shared with employees to gather input this fall.
