EdReady Sign-Up Guide

Before getting started, you will need an e-mail address. EdReady works best with browsers Google Chrome or Internet Explorer. Follow the steps below to get started.

- 1. Go to wvc.edready.org
- 2. Click "Get Started"
- 3. Enter login information, including an e-mail address. An e-mail will be sent to you shortly (this ensures you're a person and not a robot).
- 4. When the e-mail arrives, click on the link provided. You will be sent back to wvc.edready.org in order to start the assessment.

You're ready to choose and take the appropriate assessment:

- 1. Enter the appropriate key:
 - a. If you expect to place into any of the following math classes, then enter
 - "placement_level1" (without quotes) as the key:
 - i. Basic Mathematics (MATH 90)
 - ii. Pre-Algebra (MATH 93)
 - iii. Elementary Algebra (MATH 98)
 - iv. Intermediate Algebra (MATH 99)
 - b. If you expect to place into any of the following college-level math classes, then enter "placement_level2" (without quotes) as the key:
 - i. Math in Society (MATH& 107)
 - ii. Precalculus for Business (MATH 140)
 - iii. Precalculus I (MATH& 141)
 - iv. Precalculus II (MATH& 142)
 - v. Introduction to Statistics (MATH& 146)
 - vi. Business Calculus (MATH& 148)
 - vii. Calculus I (MATH& 151)
 - viii. Math for Elementary Educators I (MATH& 171)
 - ix. Finite Mathematics (MATH 200)
 - x. Symbolic Logic (PHIL& 120)
- 2. Take the assessment. Save your progress periodically. You can also stop and save your progress and come back to the test later.

You've completed the assessment. Next steps:

- Are you ready to be placed? See the guide below to get an idea of where the EdReady assessment will place you, and then contact a Math faculty or Educational Planner. To contact math faculty, please see the website at the bottom of this document. Call 509.682.6830 or stop by the Educational Planning and Testing Center on the first floor of Wenatchi Hall to schedule an appointment with an Educational Planner. Both the Math faculty and the educational planning team can look up your assessment score within EdReady and help you decide upon your best course of action. They might recommend that you continue to use EdReady to improve your score so that you can sign up for your desired class, or they might point you toward particular topics to study so that you are better prepared to succeed in your next class.
- **If you want to improve your EdReady score:** EdReady has tools for reviewing and re-learning topics you answered incorrectly on the assessment. We recommend you check with a Math faculty before continuing (see contact website below).
