• Credit for these DSST examinations will be awarded with a minimum score or better as indicated.

- Official copies of DSST test scores need to be submitted to the Admission/ Registration office for credit evaluation.
- A maximum of 10 DSST credits can be applied to a distribution area on the Direct Transfer degree (DTA). There is a maximum of 5 credits that can be awarded in world languages.
- No more than 5 DSST credits can be used to meet the writing skills requirement for a degree. DSST credit will not be used for the writing requirement for advanced English Composition.
- DSST credit is awarded a "P" grade, will not effect the GPA and will not ap to WVC residency requirements.
- Depending on the amount of other PLA exam credit earned, a maximum of 30 credits can be used towards a WVC degree. For Workforce programs, PLA credit is limited to 25% of total credits required for degree.
- There is no fee for this evaluation.
