3. Syllabus Statement: The medical terminology course prepares students for beginning studies in allied health careers. This course is a prerequisite for the Medical Assistant, Radiologic Technology, and Medical Laboratory Technology Programs at Wenatchee Valley College. The Pharmacy Technician Program also requires medical terminology in the first quarter of study. Students that successfully fulfill the requirements for articulation can get a head start in starting one of these programs.
4. Textbooks & Resources – Medical Terminology Simplified: A Programmed Learning Approach by Body System and use of the Medical Language Lab through FADavis.
5. Equipment & Tools – No specific requirements
6. Classroom instruction – Should align with the 30 hour- 3 credit requirement

Teachers are encouraged to collaborate with WVC program coordinators to promote transition to WVC programs.
