#### Relationship with CFNCW

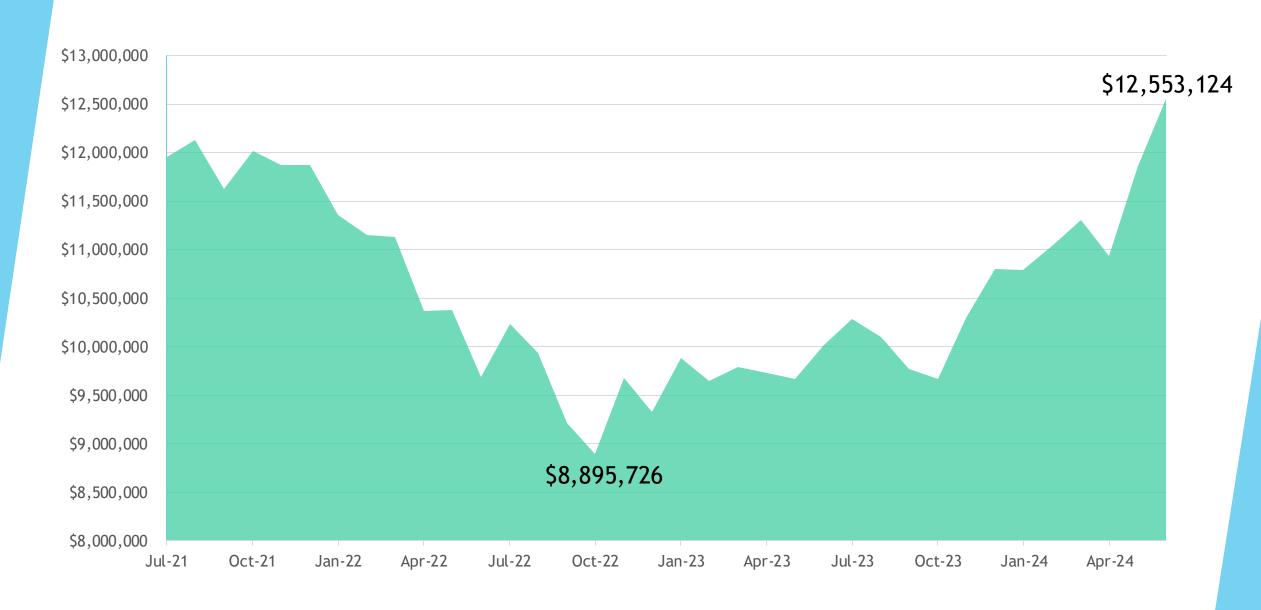
#### Benefits

- Multi-fund financial reports (e.g. monthly columnar report, annual allocation spreadsheet)
- Pooled fund investment with CFNCW partners
- Fee is reinvested in local region through CFNCW programs
- Oversight by CFNCW Investment Committee (attendance is open to any partners)

#### **Drawbacks**

- Only 1 investment option for funds (60% equity, 40% fixed)
- Fee includes investment broker fee and CFNCW management fee

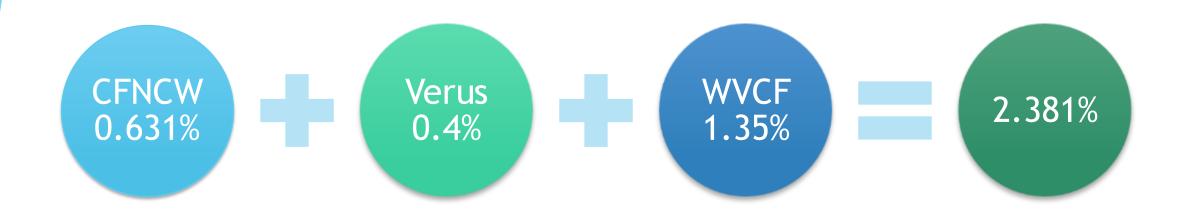
#### **CFNCW Fee**

The fee for our assets, currently comes out to about 0.631%

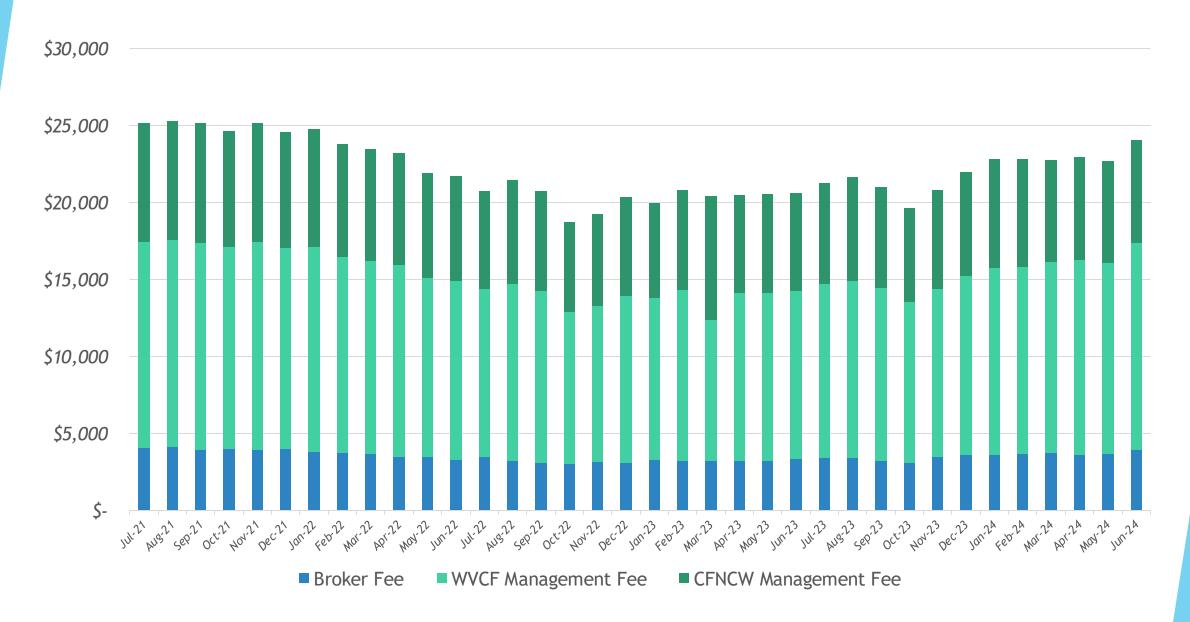

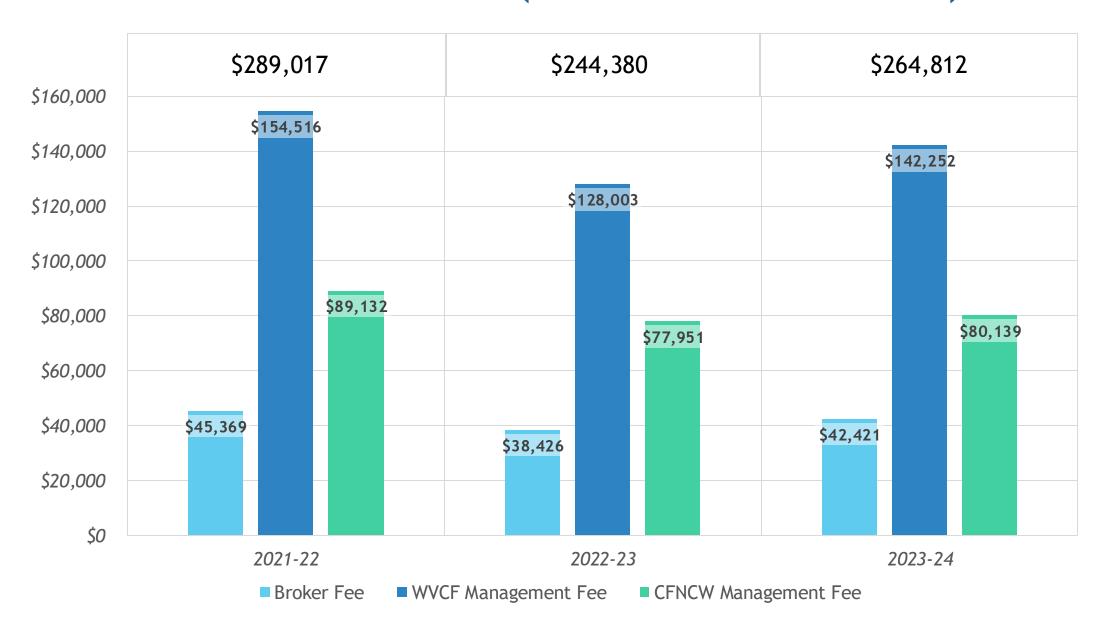
#### Fee Structure

#### Highlights

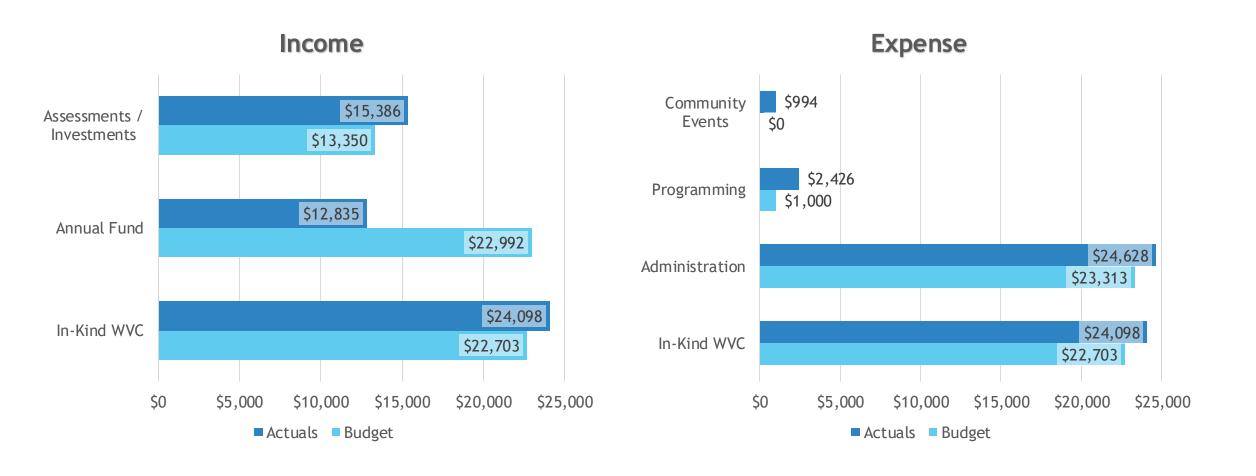
The operating budget's actual income and expenses are nearly even.

▶ We were notified of a \$3.4 million estate gift, which has been recorded as a receivable (money not yet received).

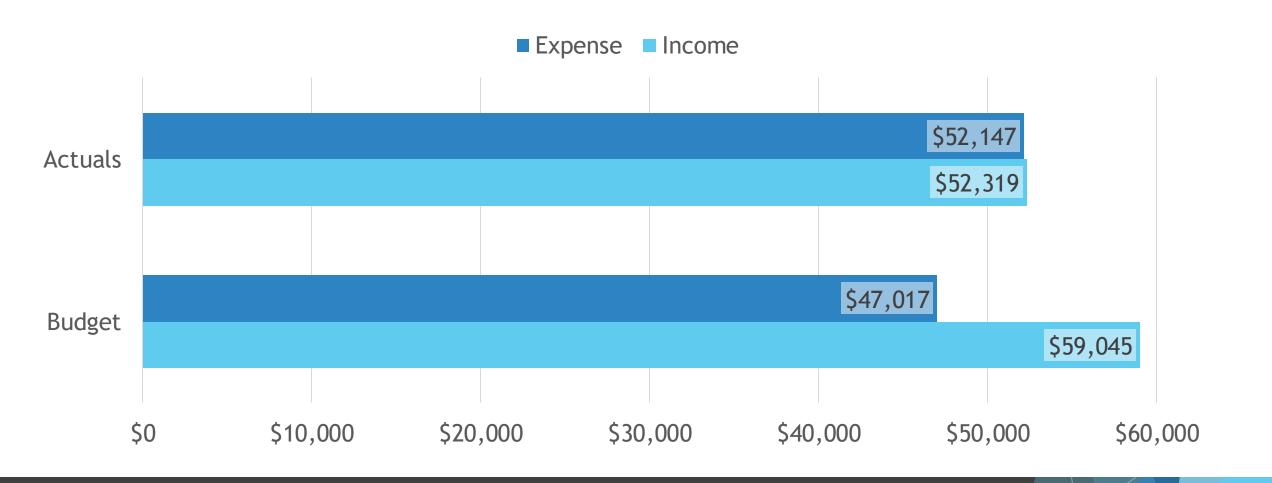
► A new scholarship, the Cheryl Ann Cooprider Memorial Scholarship, was established.

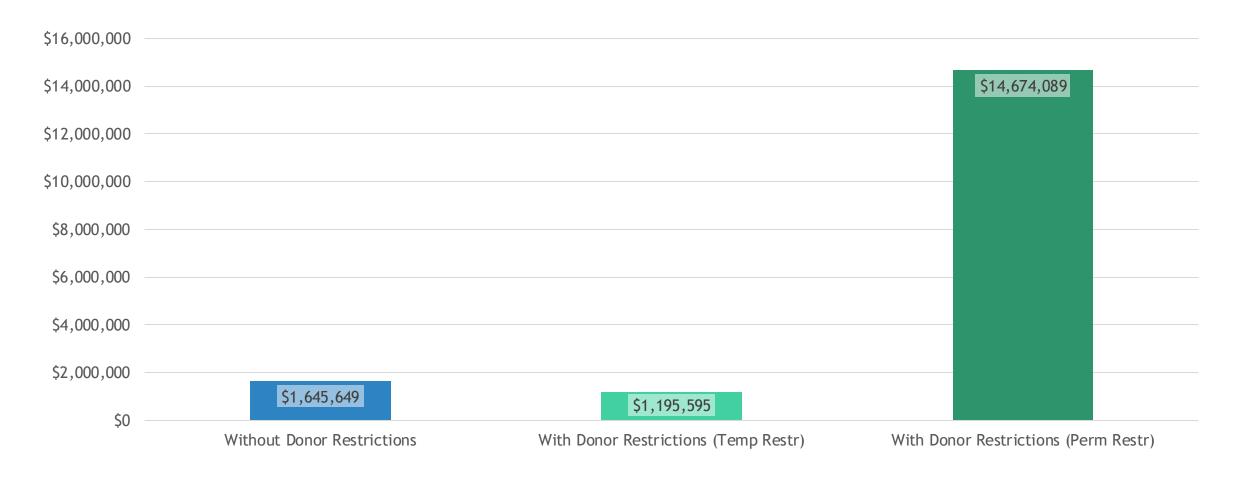
#### Operating Income Statement YTD



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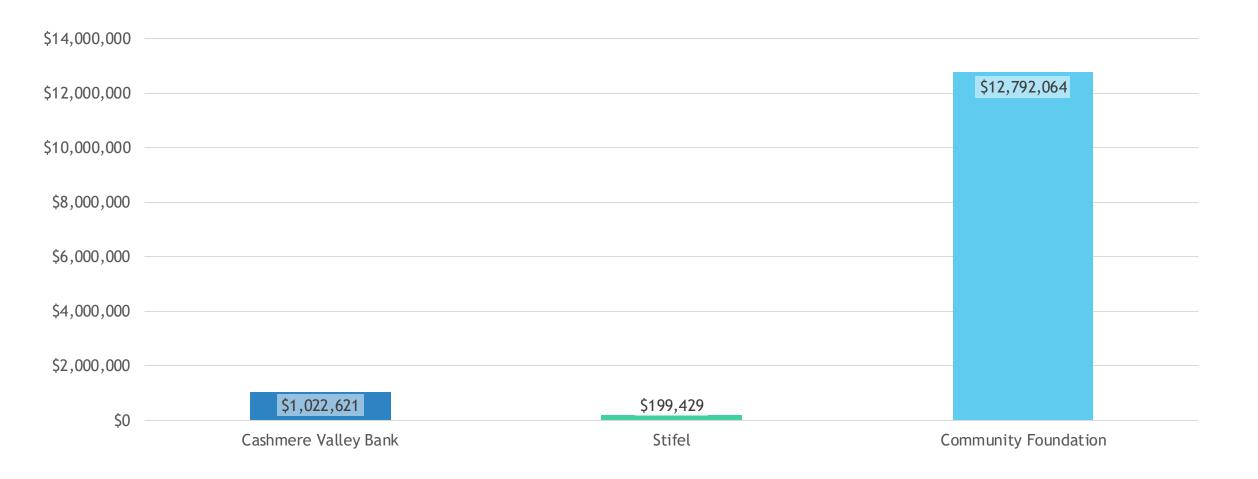


#### Income Statement Per Restrictions
